## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER 18 April 2010

### Today's Readings

*Acts 5:27-32, 40-41; Revelations 5:11-14; John 21:1-19*

The Gospel story of Jesus appearance to his apostles at the Tiberius Sea is familiar. The apostles are fishing with nothing to show for it. Jesus comes to the shore and does three things. He provides a miraculous catch of fish by telling them where to put their nets. Then he cooks a meal for them on the seashore. Jesus commissions Peter as shepherd of his flock. Full of symbols this story conveys a message of great importance. The disciples return to their old occupation. They had to live. And their leader was gone—irrevocably gone, so it seemed. *"They labored through the night and caught nothing."* How many nights and days does it seem we are making no progress—individually or as a family, a parish? Then they obey a mysterious spokesman standing on the shore. They are successful beyond their dreams—they can scarcely take in the fish. Perhaps the large number of fish caught emphasizes that a very great number of people will come to know Jesus through the labor of his disciples and the church. Is there a deeper meaning to the ordinary phrase—I heard it often as a child—*"come and eat your meal"*? It should remind us of Jesus' words at the Last Supper, *"Take and Eat,"* an invitation now repeated in every Mass. No longer do we wonder who is the center of our lives, he is present to us in his risen life. It is the one we recognize in the sacrament of Holy Communion. It is the Lord.

**CRY ROOM:** the room next to the chapel, the former Blessed Sacrament room, is now available to be used as a cry room. A TV has been set up in there so a parent may hear and follow the mass. If you take children toys in with you please take them with you when you leave. The room is still used as a prayer room during the week so please respect that.

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays 4:00 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

**Baptism:** A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

**Marriage:** Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Contact Fr. Wagner well in advance of a desired wedding date.

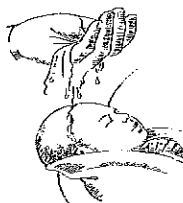

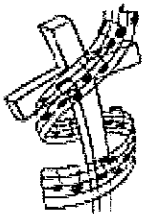

## M-Mittens, Marshmallows & Mice

♦**Circle Time:** Some letter "M" things students shared were millipede & M & M cookies. We marched with musical instruments and rolled like marbles. A "Circle Time" favorite in the 4-5 yr. old classes is the "Riddle Basket." Students take turns giving clues about a picture for others to guess what it is. Now they are beginning to understand that besides fitting the clue, it must begin with the letter of the week. It was a surprise when one of the children called out, "Moustache!" Another impressive guess followed the clue, "We use it to sing songs, or play the piano." "Microphone!" called out one clever lad! (music, the real answer, was a tough one.) The final "M" clue giver prompted, "Something you use to clean the floor." A child called out, "broom," on that one. She gave a second clue, "Only moms use it." Miss Val hopes that everyone remembers the importance of "sharing" when it comes to the m-o-p at your house. ♦**Faith Study: Stories of God's Love- 3-4s: My Church Friends.** I join with other friends of Jesus at church. We sang, (To the tune of The Muffin Man) *Do you know the Son of God? The Son of God? The Son of God? Do you know the Son of God, who died and rose again? Yes, I know... Jesus is...* 4-5s: **David Teaches Us to Pray.** David, the shepherd boy who became king, teaches us how to pray. ♦**Music & Movement: 4-5s:** (To The Farmer in the Dell) *We think mice are nice. We think mice are nice. Mice have noses that twitch and sniff. We think mice are nice.* ♦**Art/Fine Motor/Learning Activities:** 3-4s- Cut out hearts to create mice. We read If You Give a Moose a Muffin, by Laura Numeroff, and Mouse Mess, by Linnea Riley. Muffins and samples of many cheeses were MARELOUS to munch! 4-5s-After hearing The Mitten, by Alvin Tresselt, students made mittens and stuffed them with animals to re-enact the story. We also read If You Take a Mouse to School, by Laura Numeroff, and I Love You, Mouse, by John Graham. Snacks included Marshmallow mix and milk and cookies!
