Deacon Patrick's Ordination to the Priesthood will be June 3rd in 2012. We are planning on a bus or two to take a trip up to the Cathedral in Superior, Wisconsin for this special occasion. We might be offering two options: 1) going up on Saturday, over-night and some sightseeing with a return Sunday evening. 2) going up Sunday and returning that evening. Sacraments

Reconciliation: Saturdays 4:15 - 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

Baptism: A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

Marriage: Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Please contact Fr. Weber well in advance of a desired wedding date.

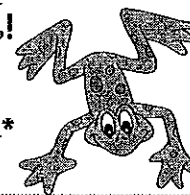

Risen Savior Rosary Guild Report

Rosary guild members are Monica Mahoney-Schroeder, Bert Cohlman, Marvelyn Kessler, Rita Thompson, Tonia Aker, Elizabeth Schumacher, Emilie Schroeder, Carla Gross, Maywin Thoreson, Nancy Ehrhardt, and Sally Wright

July 13th meeting attendees at Bethany Meadows: Marvelyn, Tonia, Bert, Rita and Carla were present. 13 rosaries were made at the meeting.

July 27nd the meeting attendees at Bethany Meadows: Marvelyn, Rita, Bert, Tonia, and Emily Loney as special guest, were in attendance. 7 rosaries were made.

To promote the rosary:

1. 280 free rosaries have been given out in the lobby and sanctuary of the church. 2 of the rosaries were given to Carla for girl Baptisms and 4 were put in the free give away basket in entrance of the church.

Rosaries to the Catholic World Wide Missions:

1 Through Fr. Terry, we have made a new connection with a missionary in Zambia, Africa, Sr. Deb Nelson. Sr Deb is a Presentation Sister from the Aberdeen community. Sr Deb had worked with Fr Terry several years ago in Miller, SD. We are excited to be making rosaries for this mission on a regular basis. A more complete report will follow on Sr Deb and her mission work.

2. Monica will contact Sr Janice Cline, a Presentation sister in Aberdeen, to inquire about any other needs they have for rosaries. For example, they have another mission in Mexico as well as their local area.

Financial support of the Carmelite sisters in Alexandria, SD:

1. Thus far, \$522 (approximately 104rosaries) total has been sent to the Carmelite monastery.

New business:

1. We are prayerfully awaiting for more parishioners to answer the calling as rosary guild members. We are hearing the trumpet call of this worlds need for the rosary, both locally and abroad..
2. In the Entrance of the church, we will make available free copies of the "The Secrets of the Rosary" by St. Louis De Montfort. St. De Montfort says, "The Rosary is a priceless treasure which is inspired by God." We will be asking those taking the books to recycle them when done. Either by passing them on to another or returning to church for redistribution.
3. We will continue to pray for the Holy Spirits guidance in the mission of the rosary guild.
