I loaded the dishwasher after we ate. I stopped teasing my sister. I was thankful for my parents. I helped my sister find her shoe. I shared my game with my little brother. I asked what I could do to help and I did it. I made my bed. I was nice to the first graders in school. I share my candy. I got ready for bed with out complaining. I helped pick out clothes for my sister. I said I am sorry to my sister. I helped my handicapped uncle. I helped take down Christmas decorations. I made the Thanksgiving Dessert and tasted it to make sure it was good.

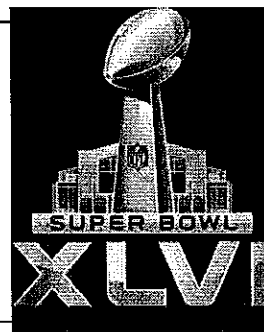

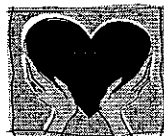
