Today's Readings

*Zechariah 9:9-10, Psalm 145:1-2, 8-9,10-11, 13-14, Romans 8:9, 11-13,
Matthew 11:25-30*

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." What truly comforting words. But realize Jesus does not say, "and I will take it from you and you won't have to deal with suffering, or pain, or inconvenience, or discomfort ever again." This is an extremely difficult message to accept, especially if you are someone who is in the midst of suffering. This, I feel, is something many of the folks I visit in the hospital fear, am I going to have to 'deal' with this for a long time, or even worse, forever? Why are we afraid to suffer, to experience pain? Isn't it part of our normal lives, and yet we find so many ways to make life less uncomfortable. Maybe that is why we struggle so much with pride and ultimately faith. What? Yup. The two are connected. Christ says, "Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart." It is under the yoke of human suffering that Christ teaches us of Himself, of humility, and ultimately of love. Hard lessons to learn, but in the classroom of discomfort, pain & suffering "you will find rest for yourselves" says our Lord Jesus Christ. (Mt. 11: 28-30) As I continue my summer with you, know of my prayers for you that we may help each other grow closer to Christ and may you all have a joy filled and fruitful 4th of July.

Sacraments

Reconciliation: Saturdays 4:15 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

Baptism: A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

Marriage: Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Please contact Fr. Weber well in advance of a desired wedding date.

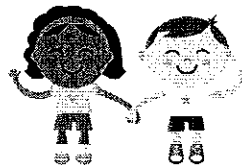
