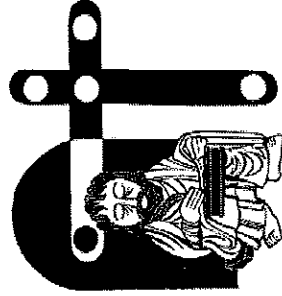

From Father Terry

Greetings to the members of Risen Savior!

I am very much looking forward to becoming a member and pastor of your faith community. I am sorry about the timing. While my commitment to the school and teaching ended the first part of June, my parish duties in the Twin Cities keeps me here until the end of July. On June 1st I celebrated my 25th Anniversary to the Priesthood, so I asked permission to have a couple of weekends to celebrate with some of the parishes I was pastor of in South Dakota. My schedule presently is the following:

I will start daily Mass in the parish on Tuesday, July 27th. My first weekend in the parish will be August 14th-15th. I will spend the weekend of July 31st-August 1st at Miller, Wessington and Polo where I was a pastor for 6 years. The weekend of August 7th-8th, I will be at Montrose and Humboldt where I first became a Pastor. Once I am with you, I will be able to give you a complete run down on the journey of 25 years to your parish. Till then, please keep me in your prayers and I will all of you.

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

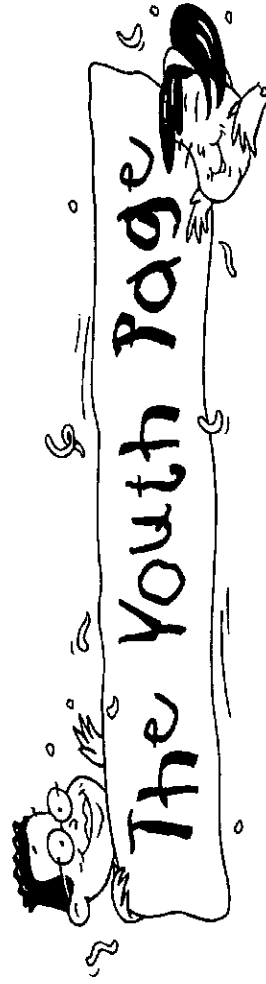
As we prepare to welcome our new pastor we need to have three new members on our pastoral council. The by-laws call for members to be selected by means of a parish election. The past few years the number of folks who agreed to be a member of the council was enough to fill the vacancies only and consequently we have had no elections. Last year the council was short one member. As the 'new' council is formed by Fr Weber a review of the Principals and Guidelines established by the diocese may be helpful.

MISSION: *The parish pastoral council is established to:*

- 1. represent the voice of the parish community to the pastor in all matters affecting the life and ministry of the community,*
- 2. help the pastor identify pastoral needs in the parish,*
- 3. help the pastor plan pastoral programs and improve pastoral services,*
- 4. evaluate the effectiveness of existing programs and services with a view to their improvement or, at times, their substitution or termination.*

AUTHORITY:

- A. The parish pastoral council has a consultative vote only. (Canon #536.2)*
- B. The parish pastoral council is a primary instrument in the parish for laity to "cooperate in the building up of the Body of Christ in accord with each one's own condition and function." (Canon #208)*

Lanes together to bowl a couple of games!

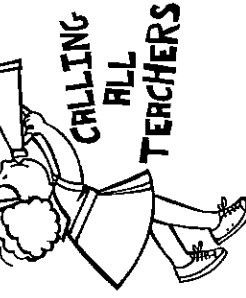

Summer Nights

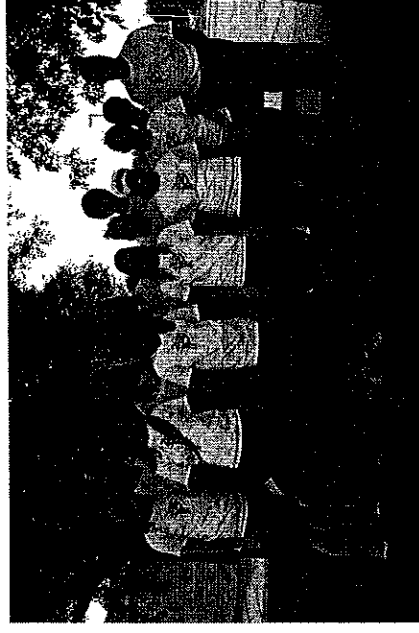
August 3-5 from 7:00-9:00 pm

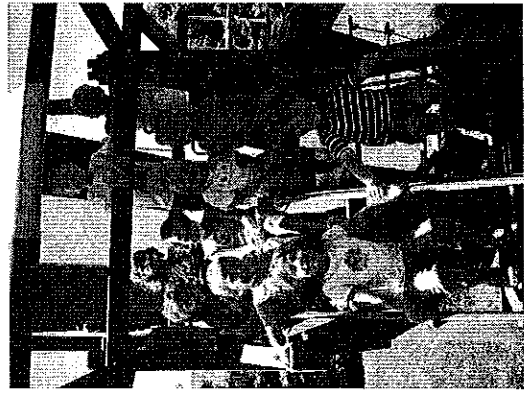

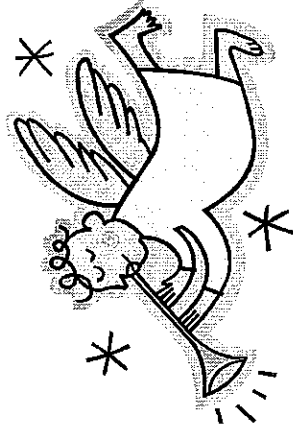

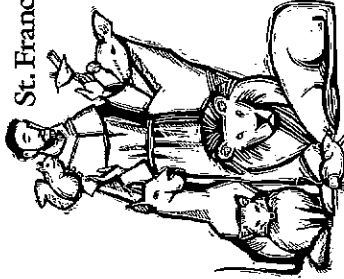
