*Today's Readings*

**2 Samuel 12:7-10, 13; Galatians 2:16, 19-21; Luke 7:36-8:3**

Saint Paul in his letter to the Galatians gives us a glimpse of the early Christian community in very serious conflict. This is also seen in the narrative on the Council of Jerusalem in the Acts of the Apostles (Ch 15). The debate centered on whether or not Gentile converts to Christianity should be required to observe the Jewish Law. What was at stake, realized or not, was the future identity of Christianity as a small Jewish sect or a catholic (universal) faith.

The verses read today come from the heart of Paul's most basic teaching: we are saved by faith, not by anything we do ourselves. At the time of the Reformation, Martin Luther used Paul's idea of justification by faith to critique the Catholic Church's practice of buying and selling indulgences. Today there is more agreement between Protestants and Catholics, with both agreeing that faith justifies us and faith must express itself in good works. (*Joint Declaration on the Doctrine of Justification by the Lutheran World Federation and the Catholic Church, October 31, 1999*)

**A REFLECTION on the Gospel reading: God is merciful and gracious. "It is in this central revelation that the chosen people and each of its members will find, every time that they have sinned, the strength and the motive for turning to the Lord to remind them to remind him of what he had exactly revealed about himself and to beseech his forgiveness." (Dives et Misericordia, Pope John Paul II)**

## **Sacraments**

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays 4:00 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

**Baptism:** A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

**Marriage:** Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Contact Fr. Wagner well in advance of a desired wedding date.

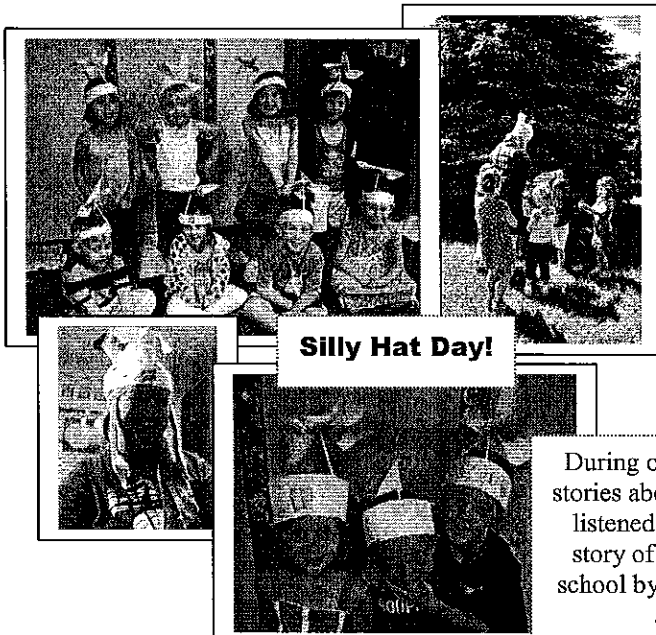
