TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

20 June 2010

Today's Readings

Zechariah 12:10-11; 13:1; Galatians 3:26-29; Luke 9:18-24

"Who do the crowds say I am?" Did Jesus have an identity problem? Was he concerned about what others thought of him? Sounds almost too human for this person we have come to know as the Christ. We know so very little from the scriptures about his early years but we imagine his life in a rural village in an occupied territory, his growing up in a very religious Jewish family, his learning a trade. We can imagine a life of some hardships interwoven with the simple joys of living. What about his psychological identity formation? When did he understand who he was? Did it dawn on him slowly or come to him in a blinding flash? Did he have doubts about it? What role did others play in his self-understanding? His parents, friends? Peter makes the bold statement that Jesus is "The Christ of God," the Messiah. For Jesus his identity was discovered in his close relationship with his Father, mother, and his band of disciples.

In Old Testament times people tended to find their identity in the Law of Moses. Paul writing to the Galatians tells them that all who are baptized in Christ are free from every social, economic, or gender distinction that formerly defined them. One's identity is not found in the Law. Their identity comes from one thing: "you are all one in Christ Jesus." So it is for us. We may look to other things, people or events to find our identity but for all of the baptized it is to be found in Christ. Do not lose your identity over the summer. Stay close to the Body of Christ.

In a joint meeting of the Finance Council and the Pastoral Council (two members present) reviewed the proposed 2010-2011 Budget. The consensus of the group was to approve a budget of \$426,290.00 for the fiscal year beginning 1 July 2010.

Sacraments

Reconciliation: Saturdays 4:00 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

Baptism: A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

Marriage: Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Contact Fr. Wagner well in advance of a desired wedding date.

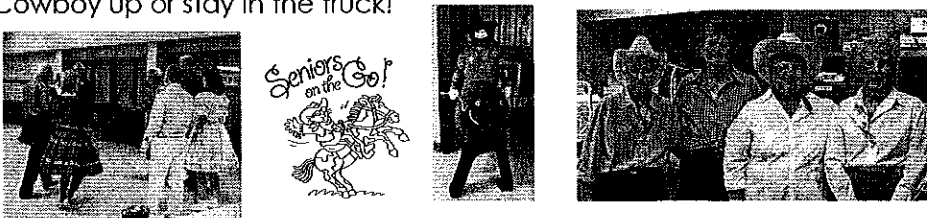


A BUSY WEEK and MANY THANKS:
