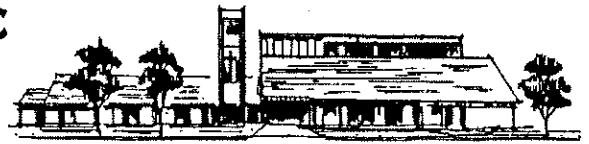

### **Sacraments**

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays 4:15 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

**Baptism:** A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

**Marriage:** Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Please contact Fr. Weber well in advance of a desired wedding date.

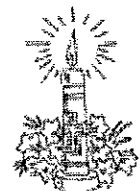

## What's Happening at Risen Savior Preschool X-King Xerxes & E-X-ercise

♦**Faith Study:** 3-4s: God's special family is called the Church. We show we are happy to belong to God. Jesus gave us His light at baptism. 4-5s **We Pray Every Day:** We thank God for His blessings when we pray. "Sometimes it is easier to raise our heart and voice to the Lord in good times when we feel blessed. But both blessings and needs can be an offering of thanksgiving. The love of family and friends and neighbors who celebrate with us in times of joy and comfort us in times of suffering reminds us that God's sustaining love always surrounds us." (Stories of God's Love Teacher's Guide) ♦**Music & Movement:** 3-4s: (Row, Row, Row) *Shine, Shine, Shine your light, for everyone to see. Thank you Jesus for your light, shining now in me!* 4-5s: (To the Oscar Mayer Weiner song) *"Oh I love it when I get my exercise! I love to run & run & have some fun, for when I run & get my exercise, I feel great like I am number one!* We continued with: throw, swim, lift, etc., & other ideas from students. ♦**Art /Fine Motor/ Learning Activities:** 3-4s: Practiced with Rhythm Sticks (fast, slow, high, low, etc.) keeping beat to Little Miss Muffet. Made spider snacks with Oreos, pretzels & Sixlets. 4-5s: The story of King Xerxes & Queen Esther, based on Esther 1, tells us that King Xerxes ruled with extra power. He expressed all of his wishes. People obeyed without excuses. Queen Esther was born at just the right time to serve God and so were we! Talked about Earth Day & the importance of taking care of God's Creation, followed by a walk to "Clean up" our play space.

Parish Finance Council Meeting  
April 12, 2011

Members present: Brian Bertsch, Julie Choudek, Merlin Sawyer, and Fr. Weber. Don Rahn was absent.

Agenda and minutes from last meeting were approved.

Financial report was gone over. Income for Women's Day Trip and Expense for Mission Trip were noted.

Parish Home loan was recorded at \$77,628.04. A new payment is expected to be made within the following week.

Stewardship Cards were recorded from April 9-10<sup>th</sup> weekend:

- 9 Simplified Giving
- 19 One Hour Prayer
- 32 One Hour Time
- 19 One Hour Service

An update on CFSA was provided:

Goal: 69,500

Pledged Amount: 46,209

Amount Collected: 37,481

Amount Needed to Reach Goal: 32,020

Department Budgets will be examined at the next meeting.

The two entry way roofs are in need of improvements from leaks. A peak will be added to both entries. With the help of volunteers, the cost is expected to be approximately \$4,000-5,000. Finance agreed this is a necessary project to complete.

Summer meeting times were brought to attention. As of now, Finance committee plans to meet every month in the summer.

Brian Bertsch acknowledged his end of term approaching for Finance Committee. He agreed to stay on until a new member has been chosen. Thank you Brian for your time and assistance!

## ***Risen Savior Rosary Guild Report***

Rosary guild members are Monica Mahoney-Schroeder, Bert Cohlman, Marvelyn Kessler, Rita Thompson, Tonia Aker, Elizabeth Schumacher, and Emilie Schroeder

**March 7<sup>th</sup> meeting** at Risen Savior Parish: Maywind, Carla, Nancy, and Monica were in attendance. 7 rosaries were made. Maywind turned in 20 rosaries that she made with the guild's take home kit.

**March 9<sup>th</sup> meeting attendees** at Bethany Meadows: Monica, Tonia, Marvelyn, Rita, and Bert were present. Ruby Peterson was a guest. 19 rosaries were made at the meeting.

**March 21<sup>st</sup>** at Risen Savior Parish: Maywind, Nancy, Monica, and Carla were in attendance. Maywind turned in 15 rosaries, some of which were of the Native American style.

**March 23** at Bethany Meadows: Marvelyn, Rita, Bert, Tonia and Monica were in attendance. 15 rosaries were made.

### **To promote the rosary:**

1. 232 free rosaries have been given out in the lobby and sanctuary of the church.
2. March 25<sup>th</sup>, Monica attended the St. Margret's home school group. She taught approximately 24 students to make corded beaded rosaries as part of their art class.
3. 10 white/girls rosaries were turned into Irene for the 1<sup>st</sup> communion class. We will continue to work on making the remaining 23 needed to for-fill the 1<sup>st</sup> Communion classes' needs.
4. We have gotten two thank yous. One from Sr Mary Clement of Lower Brule and the second from Sr Lisbeth Mary in India.

### **Rosaries to the Catholic World Wide Missions:**

1. Our guild's quarterly reports (Sept to March) was sent into Our Lady's Rosary Makers (OLRM). It reflected the 90 rosaries we had sent to the world wide missions.
2. 15 Native American rosaries were sent to the Ft. Thompson reservation (of the Sioux Falls Diocese.) to Sr. Charles Palm PO Box 47 Ft. Thompson SD 57339
3. An additional 15 Native American rosaries were sent to Lower Brule (of the Rapid City Diocese) to Sr Mary Clement Eiden PO Box 222 Lower Brule, SD 57548
4. 2 bundles of 30 (60 total) rosaries were sent with Dan Irvine to take on his mission trip to Haiti in April.

### **Financial support of the Carmelite sisters in Alexandria, SD:**

1. Thus far, \$392 (approximately 79 rosaries) total has been sent to the Carmelite monastery.

### **New business:**

1. The guild has 3 new members registered, Maywind Thoreson, Nancy Ehrhardt, and Sally Wright. Their registration fees were sent into OLRM.
2. We have developed a new avenue to promote the rosary. Fr Jim Zimmer and Deacon Jerry Walthon at Sanford hospital will distribute our rosaries to pediatric patients and families at the Children's Hospital. We will contact Avcra to offer them rosaries also.
