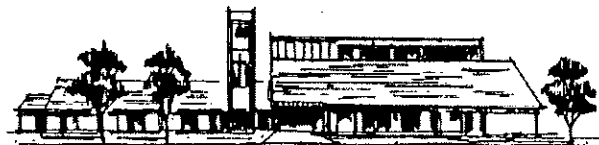

Today's Readings

Is 45:1,4-6; Psalm 96:1,3-5,7-10; 1st Thes 1:1-5b; Matt 22:15-21

One of the tasks and ministries given to us is the ongoing dialogue and communication between our Catholic Church and those of the Protestant Faith. With that dialogue and communication is the important aspect of shared prayer. This Brandon City is highly influenced by the faith lived out by many of its members in the daily activities of being a community. Our own parish is blessed by many members who live in mixed marriages of faith. I truly believe Brandon and the surrounding areas are deeply influenced by Christian values and beliefs. We owe a gift of gratitude to our neighbors and their congregations of faith. With all this in mind and after visiting with the Parish Pastoral Council, I have decided to arrange a time of prayer, celebration, and visiting with the different churches that make up the Brandon Valley Ministerium. Together we serve the needs of the wider community in many areas of needs. Together we support many ministries that shape where we live. We will take turns inviting and hosting the different congregations to a Sunday evening of prayer and fellowship. I will invite their minister to share some scripture and a reflection as part of the prayer service. If they have a choir, we will invite them to share or lead us in some songs of praise and worship. This prayer time will roughly last ½ hour with a ½ hour of refreshments and visiting to follow. I encourage you to attend as many as you can, especially if we are hosting the church that your neighbors belong to. Our first one will be with the Celebration United Methodist Church on Sunday November 6th at 7:30 Pm. Please put it on your calendar and plan to attend. If your neighbors are of that church, personally invite them to join us.

Sacraments

Reconciliation: Saturdays 4:15 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

Baptism: A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

Marriage: Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Please contact Fr. Weber well in advance of a desired wedding date.
