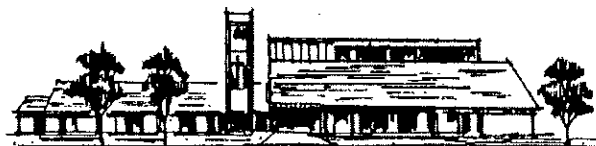

**Reconciliation:** Saturdays 4:15 – 4:45 PM or other time by appointment.

**Baptism:** A pre-Baptismal class is required for first-time parents. The class is held the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM and parents must make reservations. Class is best done prior to your child's birth.

**Marriage:** Diocesan policy requires six (6) months preparation for all couples planning marriage. A wedding date can NOT be set until this preparation is underway. Prior marriage by either party usually requires an annulment taking an additional year. Please contact Fr. Weber well in advance of a desired wedding date.

\*The month of October each year is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. This is primarily due to the fact that the liturgical feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated annually on October 7. It was instituted to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful. The feast was introduced by Pope St. Pius V (1504-1572) in the year 1571 to commemorate the miraculous victory of the Christian forces in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The pope attributed more to the "arms" of the Rosary than the power of cannons and the valor of the soldiers who fought there. *Rev. Matthew R. Mauriello*

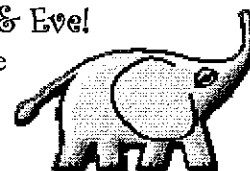
Youth Choir

God made me wonderful!* 4-5s from God Made the World: “God’s plan for family members is to live and grow together in love.” We show love for our family by helping and caring for each other and giving gifts. Lk 2:51-5-Jesus was obedient to Mary & Joseph. Jesus grew in wisdom and age and favor before all. We also read Adam & Eve, Temptation for Adam & Eve, & Leaving Eden (100 Bible Stories, 100 Bible Songs-Stephen Elkins), discussing what it means to **obey**, and did a Garden of Eden craft. 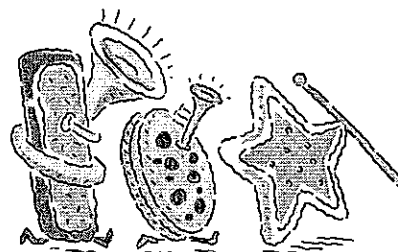
Can you help us with our biggest fundraiser this year for Risen Savior?
